Do you have some spare time in the evening or at weekends where you could run errands for the charity or do a local car boot?

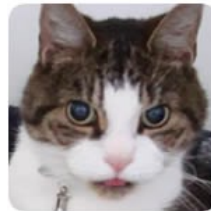

**Homeless Cat Rescue** takes in stray, unwanted and abandoned cats and kittens for re-homing. We also trap, neuter and release feral cats.

We believe strongly in neutering and spaying. All our cats over 6 months old or weighing 2kg or over are neutered before re homing. Kittens under 6 months old or weighing less than 2kg will only be re homed on the understanding that new owners get the kitten neutered at their own expense once the kitten is ready.

We also believe in micro-chipping as so many cats go missing. All our cats and kittens over the age of 12 weeks are micro chipped before going to their new homes. All our cats for re homing stay at foster homes until permanent homes are found.
